The A92 Trunk Road (Stonehaven to Charleston) (Prohibition and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 20[]

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

The Scottish Ministers propose to make the above traffic regulation order which will:

- 1. Prohibit entry to the lengths of road specified in Part 1 of the schedule of the Order by means of No Entry traffic signs which are located at the prohibited entry points to the lengths of road.
- 2. Apply a 40mph speed limit to the lengths of road specified in Part 2 of the schedule of the Order.

The reasons for making the order are:

- The No Entry prohibition is required for reasons of safety to prevent traffic from entering the off slip roads at the incorrect entry points and proceeding in the opposite direction of travel against oncoming traffic.
- To apply speed limits in the interests of road safety and to ensure that speed limits are appropriate and consistent to the new road layout and configurations resulting from the construction of the new infrastructure related to the Aberdeen Western Peripheral Route / Balmedie to Tipperty (AWPR/B-T) project.
