About the project

Haudagain roundabout is a major road junction between the A90 and A96 trunk roads in Aberdeen.

The roundabout has a limited capacity and has been the cause of significant queues and delays to traffic on the approach roads.

The A90/A96 Haudagain Improvement project includes construction of approximately 500 metres of new dual carriageway. It connects the the A90 North Anderson Drive and the A96 Auchmill Road, to

assist with reducing traffic congestion and improving journey time reliability.

The project will also cater for more inclusive, healthy and active travel modes of transport such as walking and cycling.

It includes appropriate crossing points and a new shared foot/cycle way next to the new link road and Manor Avenue.

This will provide a safer and more efficient route for pedestrians and cyclists.

ADVANCE WORKS

In advance of the contract award and planned construction of the project, **31 buildings have been demolished in the Middlefield area as part of a programme of advance work to clear the planned route.**

In the coming months, we will start work to divert several utilities, to allow construction work for the new link road to be carried out safely, while maintaining services to local residents and businesses.
