THE TRUNK ROADS (ROUTE A77) (MAYBOLE) (PROHIBITION OF  
WAITING AND LOADING) (VARIATION) ORDER 1992

Made

13th May 1992

Coming into force

1st June 1992

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1(1) as read with sections 1(2), 2(1), 2(2) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, having complied with the provisions of Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Roads (Route A77) (Maybole) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading) (Variation) Order 1992 and shall come into force on 1st June 1992.
2. The Trunk Roads (Route A77) (Maybole) (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading) Order 1987(c) shall be varied to the effect that in Schedule 2 paragraph 3, for the measurement "174" metres there shall be substituted the measurement "73 metres" and in paragraph 5 for the measurement "73 metres" there shall be substituted the measurement "174 metres".
