**The A92 Trunk Road (Halbeath to Crossgates) (40mph and
50mph Speed Limits) Order 20[]**

Coming into force - -

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make this Order and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A92 Trunk Road (Halbeath to Crossgates) (40mph and 50mph Speed Limits) Order 20[] and comes into force on .

Speed restriction

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding—
- (a) 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Part 1 of the schedule,
 - (b) 50 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Part 2 of the schedule.

Exemption

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations, or
- (b) vehicles being used in an emergency of coastguard purposes.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTHS OF ROAD

PART 1

1. That length of the A92 East Fife Regional Road being the eastbound carriageway from its junction with the Halbeath Roundabout in a generally north-easterly direction to a point 180 metres or thereby from that junction, a distance of 180 metres or thereby.

2. That length of the A92 East Fife Regional Road being the westbound carriageway from a point 180 metres from its junction with the Halbeath Roundabout in a generally south-easterly direction to that junction, a distance of 180 metres or thereby.

PART 2

3. That length of the A92 East Fife Regional Road being the eastbound carriageway from a point 180 metres or thereby north-east of its junction with the Halbeath Roundabout in a generally north-easterly direction to a point 15 metres or thereby north-east of its junction with the Crossgates Roundabout, a distance of 600 metres or thereby.

4. That length of the A92 East Fife Regional Road being the westbound carriageway from a point 15 metres or thereby north-east of its junction with the Crossgates Roundabout in a generally south-westerly direction to a point 180 metres or thereby north-east of its junction with the Halbeath Roundabout, a distance of 688 metres or thereby.
