The A78 Trunk Road (West Kilbride Incorporating Seamill) (Restricted Road) Order 2005

MadeComing into force 17th August 2005 2nd September 2005

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2)(b), 83(1) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as The A78 Trunk Road (West Kilbride Incorporating Seamill) (Restricted Road) Order 2005 and shall come into force on 2nd September 2005.

Variation of previous Restricted Roads Order

At 23.59 hours on 1st September 2005 the Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Ayrshire) Order 1975(c) is varied to the effect that paragraph 3d in the Schedule to that Order is deleted.

Commencement of new Restricted Road

3. At 00.01 hours on 2nd September 2005 the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby directed to become a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which imposes a speed limit of 30mph on a restricted road.



In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 72(3), 73(1) (a) and (2) and (50(1) of the Read Traffic Resulation Act 1907(a) as someone by Pert IX of the Transport Act 1908(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1973(a), the Secretary of State hereby directs as follows:

- 1. This order may be cited as the Trunk Words (Hastrioted Reads)(Agrahire) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 11 May 1975
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this order and the order hereby revoked as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliassent.
- 3. The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Scotland) Order 1970(e) is hereby recoked.
- h. At 11.59 pm on 11 May 1975 each of the longths of road specified in the Schedule to this order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as exended (which imposes a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on a restricted road).
- 5. At CO.Ol am on 12 May 1975 each of the lengths of read specified in the Schedule to this order shall become a restricted read for the purposes of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1987 as avended (which imposes a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on a restricted road).
