## THE A9 TRUNK ROAD (TOMATIN TO MOY) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2021

- 1. The A9 Trunk Road (Tomatin to Moy) Compulsory Purchase Order 2021, which has been made by the Scottish Ministers includes the land described in the Schedule hereto.
- 2. This land forms part of an open space.
- 3. Notice is hereby given that the Scottish Ministers in exercise of powers conferred by paragraph 11 of Part III of the First Schedule to the above mentioned Act, have certified that they are satisfied that this land is required for the widening of an existing public road within the meaning of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and that the giving in exchange of other land is unnecessary in the interests of the public because the open space land to be acquired, and other suitable land equally advantage to the public, will be available for public access post construction.
- 4. In accordance with the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020, Schedule 6, Part 3, para 9, the map showing the land to which this certificate relates will not be available for inspection at public display locations. The certificate becomes operative on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2021 but a person aggrieved by the certificate may, by application to the Court of Session within 6 weeks from that date, question its validity on the ground that the applicant's interests have been substantially prejudiced by failure to comply with any statutory requirement relating to the certificate.
