The Trunk Roads (Route A87) (Invergarry)
(40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1982



Coming into Operation 19th October 1982

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 74(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of The Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1975(b), the Secretary of State hereby makes the following order:-

1. This order may be cited as The Trunk Roads (Route A87) (Invergarry) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 19th October 1982.
2. No person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order.

SCHEDULE

That length of the Invergarry-Kyle of Lochalsh Trunk Road (Route A87) at Invergarry Village in Highland Region from a point 60 metres or thereby west of the centreline of its junction with the London-Carlisle-Glasgow-Inverness Trunk Road (Route A82) westwards for a distance of 1170 metres or thereby.
