ROAD TRAFFIC

The A85 Trunk Road (Criarlarich) (20mph and 30mph Speed Limits) Order 202[]

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2), 83(1), 84(1)(a) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Part IV of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with sections 83(1) and 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A85 Trunk Road (Criarlarich) (20mph and 30mph Speed Limits) Order 202[] and comes into force on [].

Speed limits

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding—
- (a) 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the schedule.
 - (b) 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Part 2 of the schedule.

Revocations

3. The following are revoked—
- (a) The Glasgow–Inverness Trunk Road (A82) and the Tyndrum–Oban Trunk Road (A85) (Criarlarich) (Restricted Roads) Order 1990(d).
 - (b) The A82 and A85 Trunk Roads (Criarlarich) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 1999(e).

Exemption

4. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations; or
- (b) vehicles being used in an emergency for coastguard purposes.

SCHEDULE

SPECIFIED LENGTHS OF ROAD

Article 2

PART 1

1. That length of the A85 Stirling – Crianlarich Trunk Road at Crianlarich, from a point 120 metres or thereby east of its junction with the extended centreline of Meadow Grove to a point 21 metres or thereby west of its junction with extended centreline of Willow Brae, a distance of 617 metres or thereby.

PART 2

2. That length of A85 Stirling – Crianlarich Trunk Road from a point 120 metres or thereby east of its junction with the extended centreline of Meadow Grove to a point 354 metres or thereby east of its junction with the extended centreline of Meadow Grove, a distance of 228 metres or thereby.

3. That length of A85 Stirling – Crianlarich Trunk Road from a point 21 metres or thereby west of its junction with the extended centreline of Willow Brae to a point 238 metres or thereby west of its junction with the extended centreline of Willow Brae, a distance of 217 metres or thereby.
