ROAD TRAFFIC

The A96 Trunk Road (Raigmore Interchange to East of Seafield)
(50mph Speed Limit) Order 2004

Made Coming into force 24th August 2004 7th September 2004

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A96 Trunk Road (Raigmore Interchange to East of Seafield) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 7th September 2004.

Restriction of speed

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
