




Road Works – A96 Craibstone & Dyce Drive Junctions (March 2016 to Autumn 2016) (Update April 2016)

The AWPR/B-T will significantly improve travel in and around Aberdeen and the north east of Scotland. Construction of the new Craibstone and Dyce Drive junctions will continue over the coming months to achieve completion by Autumn 2016.

The plan below shows the layout of the works in four areas within the A96 road corridor. The works include the construction of a new roundabout on the A96.



- Area I Construction of a new roundabout on the A96 to connect Craibstone Junction and the Airport Link Road.
- Area2 Further works in this area will be undertaken after the Craibstone and Dyce Drive Junctions open to traffic.
- Area 3 Construction of new signal controlled cross-roads at A96/Dyce Drive Junction and associated road works.
- Area 4 Construction of a new bridge to carry the AWPR over the A96. Further works in this area will be undertaken after the Craibstone and Dyce Drive Junctions open to traffic.

Planned Traffic Management

Traffic management will be in operation while these works are carried out and is planned to minimise disruption to road users wherever possible. Key Areas

The information below describes traffic management measures which will be implemented during each phase of the construction works in this area. Diversions will be signed when roads are closed.

March 2016 to Spring 2016	Periodic lane reductions on westbound A96 carriageway weekday off-peak (0930hrs - 1530hrs), overnight (2000hrs – 0600hrs) or at weekends (Friday 2000hrs to Monday 0600hrs).	Construction of the southern half of the new Craibstone roundabout.
	Periodic lane reductions on eastbound A96 carriageway weekday off-peak, overnight or at weekends.	Construction of the northern half of the new Craibstone roundabout.
Spring 2016 to Summer 2016	Maintaining two lanes of traffic in both directions, using the newly constructed sections of the roundabout operating with a reduced speed limit of 40mph. Periodic weekend contraflows (closing one carriageway and using the remaining carriageway to provide continuous use of running lanes in each direction by traffic	Construction of eastbound and westbound road tie-ins to the new roundabout. Temporary barriers will be in place on the A94 to protect the worldgreen

AREA 2 – JUNCTION BETWEEN THE A96 AND THE CHAPEL OF STONEYWOOD - FAIRLEY ROAD (C89C)

After the Craibstone and Dyce Drive Junctions open to traffic, traffic management measures will be required to enable the permanent closure of the A96/C89C junction around the time when the AWPR opens. Further information in respect of these measures will be publicised nearer the time.

AREA 3 - DYCE DRIVE JUNCTION

Periodic weekend shuttle working (where one lane is closed with temporary traffic lights controlling use of the remaining lane) on Dyce Drive.

Periodic weekend contraflows on Dyce Drive and the A96.

Periodic weekend lane closures on A96 eastbound and westbound.

Construction works to provide another lane in each direction on Dyce Drive for a short section. Works to A96 eastbound and westbound at Dyce Drive roundabout. Utility diversion works.

AREA 4 - CONSTRUCTION OF PERMANENT BRIDGE

Spring to Summer 2016 Weekend overnight closures of the A96 between C89C/U53C (Chapel of Stoneywood) and Dyce Drive for three weekends during this period, with local diversions in operation. Further information will be publicised in respect of these closures nearer

After the Craibstone and Dyce Drive Junctions open to traffic, traffic management measures will be required to enable removal of the temporary bridge over the A96. Further information in respect of these measures will be publicised nearer the time.

Installation of beams for the permanent bridge carrying the AWPR over the A96.

We will make every effort to minimise disruption where possible, however road users should expect some disruption and should allow additional time for journeys. Hours of Work

Construction of works will proceed during operating hours of 0700hrs-1900hrs Monday to Friday and 0800hrs- 1300hrs on Saturday. Where any additional hours are required to complete these works, then these will be

agreed in advance with the Local Authority. At all times best practice methods will be used to keep any disturbance to a minimum. Please note that to minimise disruption to road users traffic management may be kept in place throughout the duration of the works.
