## TERMS OF REFERENCE

#### **PURPOSE AND REMIT**

The Islands Transport Forum is being facilitated by Transport Scotland and chaired by the Minister for Transport and Islands.

The remit of the group is to consider strategic transport issues affecting the islands and to ensure a greater involvement of the Islands Councils and those other local authorities with inhabited islands in the design, commissioning and where appropriate properly funded delivery of Transport Services to, from and within the Islands with the purpose of achieving:

- continuous improvement in air and ferry services to, from and within the Islands;
- the most fair and efficient use of air and ferry resources, to the benefit of the Islands and Scottish Government;
- integrated transport services that are designed and commissioned with a view to ensuring sustainable economic growth and community development within the Islands.

The membership of the group is by invitation only.

# **Transport Scotland**

It should be noted that this group has been set up to add value at a strategic level to the current key forums for Ferries and Aviation interests (for example operational matters such as route specific issues should be considered elsewhere)

#### **REVIEW**

The group will review the relevance and value of its work and the terms of reference on an annual basis.

The need for further development of and resourcing of the governance structure will be kept under review, sharing facilitation responsibilities between the constituent organisations where necessary.

## **HOW DO WE WORK**

The work of the group will involve solution focussed discussion and members will be asked to provide constructive input that moves the agenda forward.

The Forum will meet twice per annum.

It is intended to make agendas and minutes of meetings available publically or to non-members at the discretion of the Group

Dates will be fixed as far in advance as possible and members are asked to commit the meetings where possible. Members should inform Transport Scotland if a substitute is to represent a member.

Every effort will be made to circulate relevant documents as far in advance as possible (a week as minimum), however time restraints may occasionally prevent early circulation. A record of the discussions will be circulated where possible within a week of the meeting,
