Declarations of Interest

1. No declarations of interest were made.

Minutes of Previous meetings

2. The minutes of the meeting of 22 September were agreed.

Communications

3. The weekend press coverage was discussed. For the week ahead A9 average speed cameras go live on Tuesday and new flights to/from London City airport for Scottish airports and Ministerial events for this week include the new launch of the Legacy 2014 Active Travel Programme.

KPI'S

4. The routine update on Key Performance Indicators was discussed in detail and noted. There were no new major issues, with Directors noting relevant detailed points on our major projects and policies. On the operational side, including HR issues, there were no issues to highlight.

Corporate Correspondence Statistics

5. For Correspondence (PQs, MCS, Chief Exec Correspondence, and FOI cases) the figures covered August 2014, performance was noted as good. Since August included some recess time the number of PQs was lower than normal levels, and we saw similar patterns in other areas.

Corporate Risk Register
