The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (c) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the A86 Trunk Road (Newtonmore) (30mph Speed Limit) Variation and Newtonmore Primary School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 26th January 2006.

Variation of the A86 Trunk Road (Newtonmore) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2002

- (1) The A86 Trunk Road (Newtonmore) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2002(c) is varied in accordance with the following paragraphs.
- (2)In article 2 at the beginning insert "Subject to article 2A below."
- In article 2 for "the Schedule" substitute "Schedule 1"

- "2A. (1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 20mph when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).
- (2) A 20mph speed limit applies to the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order when a 20mph speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(a)."
- (5) The Schedule is renumbered as Schedule 1.
- (6) After the Schedule to the Order insert the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order.

That length of the A86 Spean Bridge – Kingussie Trunk Road at Newtonmore from a point 19 metres or thereby southwest of the extended southwest kerbline of Golf Course Road to a point 72 metres or thereby northeast of the extended southwest kerbline of Golf Course Road, a distance of 91 metres or thereby.
