We will be holding Public Exhibitions for the A9 Pass of Birnam to Tay Crossing dualling project as part of the A9 Dualling Programme. These exhibitions will give local communities and road users the opportunity to see a range of mainline and junction options for this section.

Public Exhibitions will take place in the Main Hall at Birnam Arts Institute, Station Road, Dunkeld, PH8 0DS on Wednesday 27th January, 1100 - 1900 and Thursday 28th January 1100 - 1600. Plans showing the mainline and junction options will be available to view and representatives from Transport Scotland and Jacobs will be at the exhibitions to answer any questions.
