Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with notice of planned works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC).

FCBC, the Principal Contractor working on the FRC on behalf of Transport Scotland, is planning to carry out works near Ferrymuir Roundabout during the night of Monday 13th October and Tuesday 14th October 2014.

The works will include removing the splitter island to the south of Ferrymuir Roundabout on the Monday night, surfacing the road and installing a service duct 85 metres to the south of the splitter island across the B800. On the Tuesday night, surfacing works will be completed and existing lane markings will be removed and new markings installed. Residents may wish to keep windows closed during the time that line removal work is being undertaken.

The effect of the changes in lane markings will be to temporarily reduce the lanes to one lane in each direction.

Each night the works will commence at 8pm with a view to being completed by 6am the following morning. Our aim is to complete the noisiest activities each evening by 10pm.

The plant involved between the two nights will include temporary lighting, jackhammers, excavator, dumper, vibrating plate compactor, vibrating roller, hot air lance, white lining equipment and site transport.

It is not reasonably practicable for these works to be executed within normal working hours. The hours have been approved by the Employer's Representative. Noise mitigation will be implemented by using best practicable means including the use of modern plant.

Should the works be delayed by unforeseen circumstances, they will be continued into the evenings following the stated dates until they are completed.

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience our activities may cause and also to thank you for your patience and consideration to date.

The works as described above are an essential part of the overall Forth Replacement Crossing project, which is necessary due to concerns over the long term viability of the existing road bridge. The new crossing will maintain a vital link in the east of Scotland road network which is key to the wider Scottish economy.
