Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with an update of planned evening and overnight works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC).

The evening and overnight shifts are required to mitigate the risk of the work falling into winter working where the quality of work and health and safety of the workforce might be adversely affected.

The out of normal working hours work includes carrying out paint repairs and steelfixing on the Approach Viaduct South from Pier S7 (immediately to the south of Society Road) heading north to meet the cable stayed bridge. This will be done with a very limited workforce in terms of numbers, no more than twenty operatives.

This squad will start work at 5pm daily and finish at 5am the following morning, stopping for a full weekend once a fortnight. The nature of these operations, which will be carried out by hand with no need for large items of plant, will mean that we anticipate no disturbance to our neighbours.

The work is scheduled to commence on Monday 15th August 2016 and will continue until we are sure we are safe from the potential adverse effects of winter working.
