Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with an update of planned overnight and daytime works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC) in the Ferrymuir area.

The planned works will have a significant impact on road users in the Ferrymuir area and South Queensferry in general over the forthcoming weekend.

The works will involve the resurfacing of the Ferrymuir Roundabout over this coming weekend between Friday 28<sup>th</sup> October 20:00hrs to Tuesday 01 November 06:00hrs.

In order to complete the surfacing works we are introducing both Friday night working and Monday night working to supplement the Saturday night and Sunday night working previously intimated.

**Access to the retail park will be available at all times throughout the duration of these works.**

Temporary signs advising road users of these planned closures have been erected.

The plant to be deployed in the execution of the works will be a road planer, tipper lorries, surfacing machines, chipping machines, vibrating rollers, excavators, dumpers and compressed air tools.

We will aim to minimise any cutting or breaking at night time.

Again, we would like to convey our apologies to the road users and residents who have been and will be inconvenienced by our works in the Ferrymuir area.

**The times indicated can be influenced by many factors and may change without warning near or during the time of execution. Also, the overall duration of each element may require to be extended to achieve completion should unforeseen circumstances be encountered.**
