

The Aberdeen Western Peripheral Route (AWPR) is a 46km long dual carriageway proposed jointly by the Scottish Executive, Aberdeen City Council and Aberdeenshire Council.

The route corridor for the Northern Leg was selected in 2002 following development and assessment of options by NESTRANS. This work is described in a separate assessment produced by NESTRANS using the Scottish Transport Appraisal Guidance (STAG) methodology.

The route corridor for the Southern Leg and Fastlink was selected in 2005 following consideration of alternative corridors by Transport Scotland. This work is described in a separate Consolidation Assessment Report.

Various options have been considered within the route corridor and these are described in the Environmental Statement. This work led to the identification of the preferred route, which is described in the published Draft Road Orders and Environmental Statement, with further information being provided within this exhibition.
