

- Reducing journey times many journeys in and around the city will be cut be half
- Cutting congestion some 38,000 vehicles per day will be attracted to the route in the opening year, cutting congestion at existing choke points and reducing traffic on unsuitable rural routes
- The following reductions in traffic levels are anticipated in the opening year compared to if the scheme is not constructed:
 - 13% less vehicles on Auchmill Road to the west of Haudagain Roundabout
 - 16% less vehicles on the A90 north of Mill of Mundurno Roundabout
 - 11% less vehicles on Bridge of Dee
 - over 70% less vehicles on the B979 Netherley Road
- Improving road safety predicted 53 less accidents per year by 2026
- Improving air quality air quality will be improved in Aberdeen city centre
- Growing the economy attracting and retaining businesses in the North-east through improved infrastructure
