**THE A82 AND A85 TRUNK ROADS
(CRIANLARICH) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1999**

Made	27 th May 1999
Coming into force	7 th June 1999

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him (a) by sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedures) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 and A85 Trunk Roads (Criannlarich) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 7th June 1999.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30mph.

SCHEDULE

1. That length of the A82 Trunk Road at Crianlarich from a point 700 metres or thereby south of its junction with the A85 Trunk Road in a northerly then north westerly direction to a point 570 metres or thereby north west of its junction with the A85 Trunk Road, a distance of 1270 metres or thereby.
2. That length of the A85 Trunk Road at Crianlarich from its junction with the A82 Trunk Road in a south easterly direction for a distance of 580 metres or thereby.
