# The A99 Trunk Road (Wick) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 202[]

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2), 83(1), 84(1)(a) and (c) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act  $1984(\mathbf{a})$  and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section  $84(2)(\mathbf{b})$  of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987( $\mathbf{c}$ ).

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A99 Trunk Road (Wick) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 202[] and comes into force on XX XXX 202[].

### **Speed Limit**

**2.** No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule.

#### Revocation

**3.** The A99 Trunk Road (Wick) (Restricted Road) Order 2003 is revoked(**d**).

### Exemption

4. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

(a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(e) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations; or

# SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A99 Latheron – Wick Trunk Road at Wick from a point 275 metres or thereby south of its junction with the U3557 Hospital Road in a generally northerly direction to its junction with the A882 Georgemas to Wick Road, a total distance of 1.005 km or thereby.
