ROAD TRAFFIC

The A985 Trunk Road (Kincardine Eastern Link Road) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2004

Made 27th August 2004
Coming into force 3rd September 2004

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A985 Trunk Road (Kincardine Eastern Link Road) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 3rd September 2004

Restrictions of speed

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

30MPH SPEED LIMIT

That length of the new A985 Trunk Road (Kincardine Eastern Link Road) from a point 10 metres or thereby north of the Kincardine Bridge in an easterly direction along the new A985 Trunk Road (Kincardine Eastern Link Road) for a distance of 110 metres or thereby as shown hatched on the Plan.
