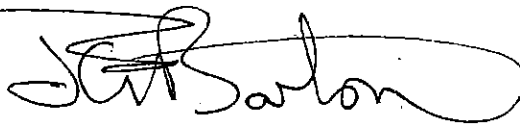
ROAD TRAFFIC

The A85 Trunk Road (St Fillans) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2001

*Made**18th June 2001**Coming into force**2nd July 2001*

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them (a) by sections 82(2)(b), 83(1), 84(1)(a) and 124(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c), hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A85 Trunk Road (St Fillans) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2001 and shall come into force on 2nd July 2001.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The Tayside Region (Restricted Roads) Order 1988 is varied to the effect that Schedule Part 1 section 51 ST FILLANS is deleted.

SCHEDULE

That length of the A85 Trunk Road from a point 75 metres or thereby east of the junction of the A85 with South Lochearn Road (C470) westwards to a point 360 metres or thereby west of the junction of the A85 with the entrance to the "Four Seasons Hotel", a distance of 1.8 kilometres or thereby.
