THE FORT WILLIAM-MALLAIG TRUNK ROAD (A830) (CORPACH) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1992

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as read with section 124(1)(d) of that Act, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedures) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Fort William-Mallaig Trunk Road (A830) (Corpach) (40mph speed limit) Order 1992 and shall come into force on 14th December 1992.
- No person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- Paragraph 1 of the schedule to the Trunk Roads (40mph speed limit) (Inverness-shire) (Consolidation) Order 1974(c) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

That length of the Fort William-Mallaig Trunk Road (A830) at Corpach:

- 1. From a point 46 metres or thereby west of the west entrance to the Argo Wiggin paper mill to a point 20 metres or thereby west of the centre line of Farrow Drive, a distance of 870 metres or thereby.
- 2. From a point 305 metres or thereby east of the centre line of Hillview Drive to a point 118 metres or thereby east of the centre line of East Tom Moine Road a distance of 500 metres or thereby.
