ROAD TRAFFIC

The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads)(Fife Region) Order 1976

Made	4th May	1976
Coming into operation	1st June	1976

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 72(3) and 73(1)(a) and (2) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1973(c), the Secretary of State hereby directs as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads)(Fife Region) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1976.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this order and the order hereby revoked as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads)(Fife) Order 1975(e) is hereby revoked.
4. Each of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended, (which imposes a speed limit of 30 mph on a restricted road).
5. The length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended (which imposes a speed limit of 30 mph on a restricted road).

SCHEDULE 1

1. That length of the Kincardine-Kirkcaldy Trunk Road (Route A92) at Hillend in the Fife Region from a point 153 yards or thereby south-west of the junction with Letham Hill Avenue to a point 111 yards or thereby east of the junction with Route B916, a distance of 552 yards or thereby.
2. That length of the Dennyloanhead-Kincardine-Kirkcaldy Trunk Road (Routes A876 and A985) at Kincardine in the Fife Region from a point 125 yards or thereby south-west of the south-west portal of the Kincardine-on-Forth Bridge to a point 205 yards or thereby east of the entrance to Burnbrae, a distance of 1650 yards or thereby.
3. That length of the Kincardine-Cupar Trunk Road (Route A977) at Kincardine in the Fife Region from the junction with Routes A876 and A985 to a point 260 yards or thereby south of the junction with Kilbagie Street, a distance of 436 yards or thereby.
4. That length of the Kirkcaldy-St Andrews Trunk Road (Route A915) at Leven in the Fife Region from a point 40 yards or thereby west of the centre line of Glenlyon Road to a point 411 yards or thereby west of the centre line of the road leading to Blacketyside Cottages, a distance of 1839 yards or thereby.
5. That length of the Kirkcaldy-St Andrews Trunk Road (Route A915) at Windygates in the Fife Region from a point 61 yards or thereby south of the projection of the north boundary wall of Smithy Hill Cottages to the junction with the west boundary of Dunolly Gardens, a distance of 1276 yards or thereby.
6. That length of the Kincardine-Cupar Trunk Road (Route A91) at Auchtermuchty in the Fife Region from a point 34 yards or thereby west of the junction with High Road to a point 129 yards or thereby east of the east kerbline of Middleflat, a distance of 1400 yards or thereby.
7. That length of the Kincardine-Cupar-St Andrews Trunk Road (Route A91) at Cupar in the Fife Region from a point 48 yards or thereby east of the entrance to Hope Park to a point 102 yards or thereby east of the entrance to Eden Park, a distance of 1897 yards or thereby.
8. That length of the Cupar-St Andrews Trunk Road (Route A91) at Dairsie in the Fife Region from the south-west corner of the School Policies to the Cupar District boundary, a distance of 625 yards or thereby.
9. That length of the Kirkcaldy-St Andrews Trunk Road (Route A921) at Colinsburgh in the Fife Region from a point 137 yards or thereby east of the junction with the east kerbline of Fairfield Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 630 yards or thereby.
10. That length of the Kirkcaldy-St Andrews Trunk Road (Route A921) at Kingsbarns in the Fife Region from a point ~~21~~²¹ yards or thereby ~~north~~^{north} of the centre line of the ~~unclassified road leading to the shore~~ in a northerly direction for a distance of 459 yards or thereby.
11. That length of the Kirkcaldy-St Andrews Trunk Road (Route A915) at Lundin Links in the Fife Region from a point 215 yards or thereby west of the centre line of the unclassified road leading to Filmuir to a point 17 yards or thereby east of the centre line of the unclassified road leading to Blindwells, a distance of 1869 yards or thereby.

12. That length of the Cupar--St Andrews--Kirkcaldy Trunk Road (Route A91 and A918) at St Andrews in the Fife Region from a point 35 yards or thereby west of the access road to the University Buildings to a point 58 yards or thereby south of the centre line of St Nicholas Farm Road, a distance of 2602 yards or thereby.

13. That length of the Kirkcaldy--St Andrews Trunk Road (Route A915 and A921) at Upper Largo in the Fife Region from a point 16 yards or thereby south of the junction with South Feus to a point 43 yards or thereby west of the access to Buckthorns Farm, a distance of 629 yards or thereby.

SCHEDULE 2

That length of the Kirkcaldy--St Andrews Trunk Road (Route A915) at Windygates in the Fife Region from the junction with the west boundary of Dunolly Gardens in an easterly direction for a distance of 224 yards or thereby.
