The A977 Trunk Road (Kincardine) (30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2008

Made

13th June 2008

Coming into force

27th June 2008

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A977 Trunk Road (Kincardine) (30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2008 and shall come into force on 27th June 2008

SCHEDULE

Part 1

30 mph Speed Limit

That length of the A977 Gartarry - Kincardine Trunk Road from a point 107.5 metres or thereby east of the projected east kerbline of Forth View, Kincardine to its junction with the A977 Gartarry - Kincardine Trunk Road eastwards for a distance of 120 metres or thereby.

Part 2

40 mph Speed Limit

That length of the A977 Gartarry - Kincardine Trunk Road from a point 227.5 metres or thereby east of the projected east kerbline of Forth View, Kincardine to its junction with the A977 Gartarry - Kincardine Trunk Road eastwards for a distance of 454 metres or thereby.

**THE A977 TRUNK ROAD (KINCARDINE) (30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2008**

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS hereby give notice that they have made the above Order under section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will have the effect of imposing a 30 mph and 40 mph speed limit respectively on the following lengths of road:

30 mph Speed Limit

That length of the A977 Gartarry - Kincardine Trunk Road from a point 107.5 metres or thereby east of the projected east kerbline of Forth View, Kincardine to its junction with the A977 Gartarry - Kincardine Trunk Road eastwards for a distance of 120 metres or thereby.

40 mph Speed Limit

That length of the A977 Gartarry - Kincardine Trunk Road from a point 227.5 metres or thereby east of the projected east kerbline of Forth View, Kincardine to its junction with the A977 Gartarry - Kincardine Trunk Road eastwards for a distance of 454 metres or thereby.

The effect of the Order is as described in Notice 1501/139 in the Edinburgh Gazette on 23rd November 2007 No.26359 and the Dunfermline Press dated 29th November 2007. The Order comes into force on 27th June 2008

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to the Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule.

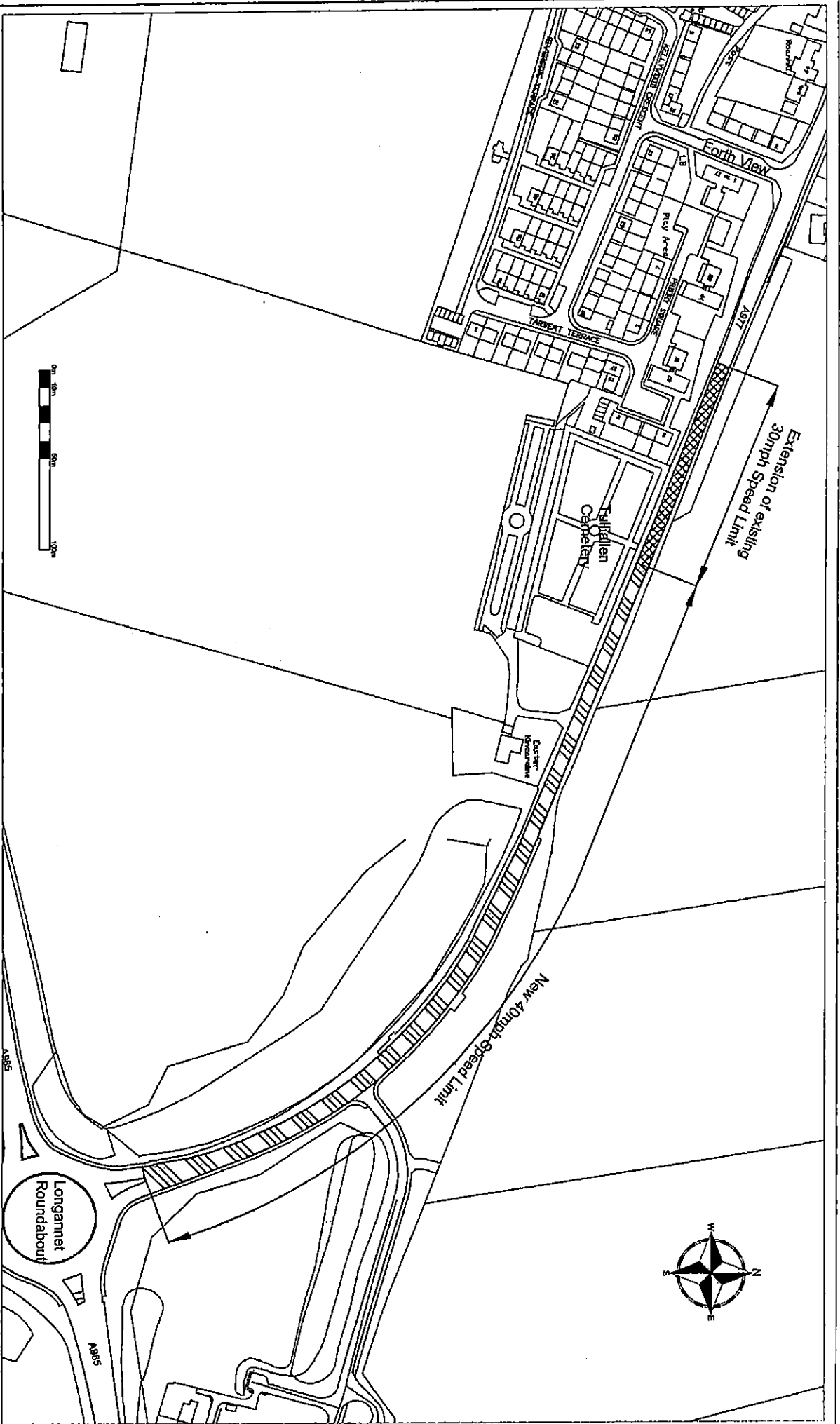
