## SCHEDULE

## PART 1

## PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY TO BE EXTINGUISHED

- A length of the existing public right of way, on the Balnaspirach Nairn Moss Lands Road (U3226), in a generally north-westerly direction, leading to the Balnaspirach House, Nairn, IV12 5NY from the B9091 – Croy – Clephanton – Kildrummie – Nairn Road.
- 2. A length of the existing public right of way, in a generally south south-westerly direction leading to the existing A96 Trunk Road from Waterloo Eastertown Inshoch Road (U2997).

## PART 2

# ALTERNATIVE RIGHT OF WAY TO BE PROVIDED

- 1. A public right of way from the A96 Trunk Road, in a generally northerly then northwesterly direction, leading to the Balnaspirach House, Nairn, IV12 5NY.
- 2. A public right of way, in a generally easterly direction along the Waterloo Eastertown Inshoch Road (U2997), then crossing under the A96 Trunk Road in a generally south south-easterly direction, then a generally west south-westerly direction, leading to the existing public right of way.
