ROAD TRAFFIC

The A737 Trunk Road (Beith) (Restricted Road) Order 2000

Made 11th August 2000
Coming into force 25th August 2000

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 82(2)(b), 83(1) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The A737 Trunk Road (Beith) (Restricted Road) Order 2000 and shall come into force on 25th August 2000
2. The Strathclyde Regional Council (Restricted Roads) (Transitional) Order 1985 shall be varied to the effect that in Schedule 1 to that Order the text under reference AY/A737-6 in the column headed "Length of Road in the Region of Strathclyde" is deleted.
3. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby directed to become a restricted road for the purposes of section 82 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

SCHEDULE

That length of the A737 Trunk Road at Beith from its junction with Roebank Road (B7049) in a northerly direction via Roebank Road, to a point 63 metres or thereby north of the north kerb of the blocked off side road between Nos 52 and 54 Roebank Road, a distance of 0.23 kilometres or thereby.
